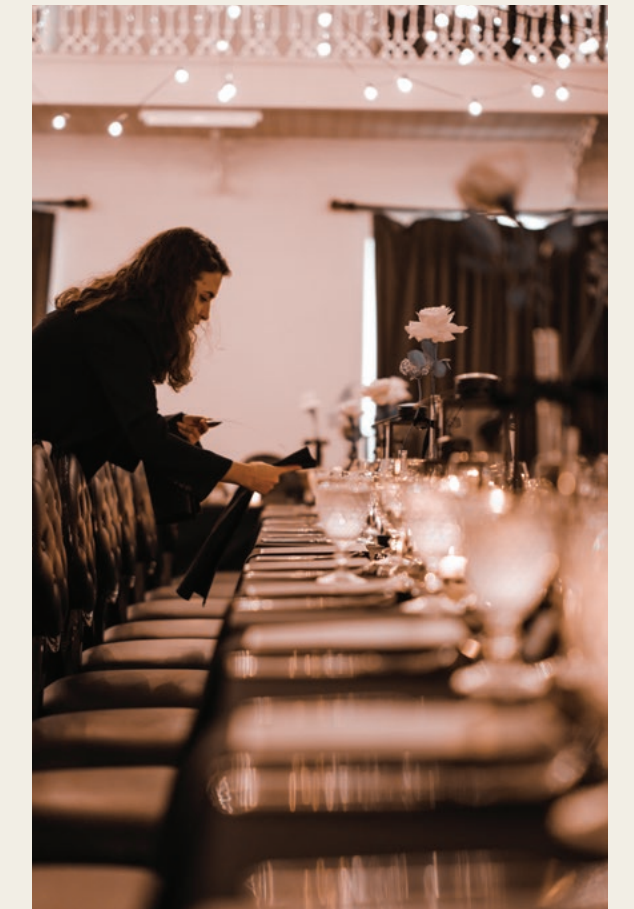

MORRIN CENTRE



Located in the heart of Old Québec, the Morrin Centre is a nationally recognized heritage site and a leading cultural hub for Québec City's anglophone community. Steeped in history, this site offers a look into the fascinating past of the former prison, Victorian college and magnificent library. 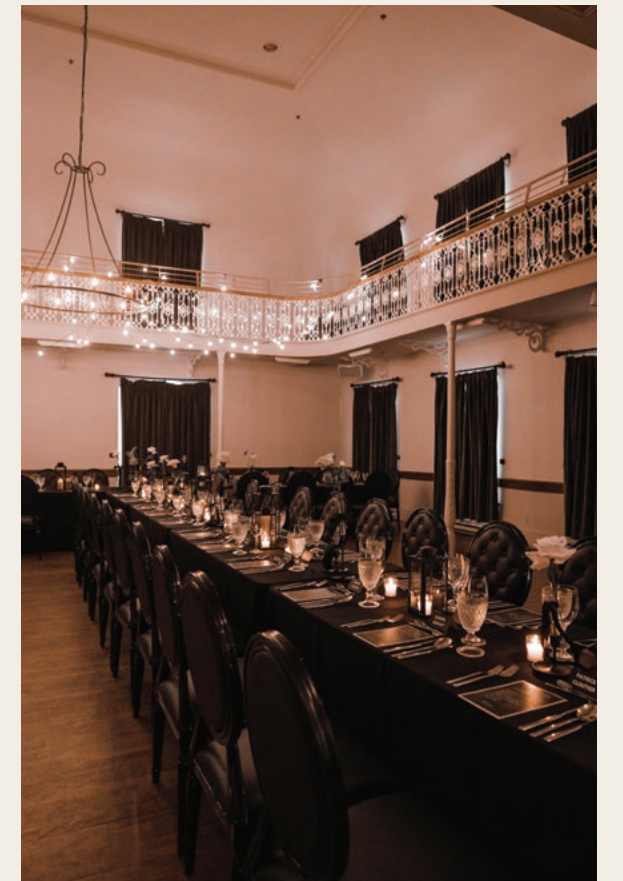

Designated a National Historic Site of Canada, the Cercle de la Garnison is a private club housed in former military buildings, offering several traditionally elegant rooms as well as a magnificent outdoor garden.

Since its founding, the Garnison Club has been housed in the former Royal Engineers' building on Saint-Louis Street. It was here that the plans for the Citadelle and several other military works were drawn up. Expanded several times over the years, this building is still the headquarters of the Cercle de la Garnison.
